ACPHD will help determine if the multiple cases can be defined as an outbreak and will provide guidance and answer any questions about the ACPHD Covid contact investigation process and safety measures that should be followed. Outbreaks are required to be reported to ACPHD when case numbers meet the thresholds-defined-by-CPDH.(6/20/23)

We have protocols in place relating to how leadership will communicate with students, staff, and parents about cases and exposures at the school to maintain confidentiality for all staff and students impacted by Covid. Any letters or communications to staff or community members will be confidential and will not use names or other identifying information about positive Covid cases.
